ORDER OF THE COURT

On *November 26, 2025* a hearing was held in the above matter and the following order was made:

This application under s. 23 of the Repair and Storage Lien Act(RSLA) was heard today. After hearing submissions by Counsel and reading the material submitted by both the applicant and respondent, I order that the respondent was not entitled to a possessory or non-possessory lien encumbering the 2020 Honda CRV VIN 2HKRW2H9XLH215204(the vehicle). I further order that the respondent had no right to sell the vehicle and I hereby order the respondent to pay the following in damages:

Damages for conversion and intentional interference with contractual relations: \$30,510.00

Interest at the applicant's contractual rate of \$7.51 per day for 664 days: \$4,986.64

Post Judgment interest in accordance with the Courts of Justice Act.

Costs are awarded to the applicant in the amount of \$7,500.00 plus HST.
